Discussion ideas

Some of these questions are more suited to younger children and others to the older children. It's up to you to pick a choose what works for your family.

1. Name 3 things that would be impossible for you to do?
2. When Jesus died on the cross it seemed to his disciples that he was gone forever, that it would be impossible for them to see, talk to or be with Jesus again. But God had a different plan, how did God show his power and love?
3. This is a really, really important part of believing in Jesus, because if we are going to choose to be a follower of Jesus then God will give us a new life as well and we can live with Him in heaven forever.

What questions do you have about this promise of God?

Allow your kids to ask any questions they have; this is a great way to get an understanding of where they are at in their faith journey. Don't be afraid to say that you don't know the answer to everything, kids ask really tricky questions sometimes. Just affirm them, that it is a great question and assure them that you will do some research and get back to them. Then make sure you do 😊

4. Today we have been reminded that nothing is impossible for God, how does that make you feel, that you can be friends with a God that loves you and can do anything at all!

Resurrection Prayer.

(This pray is best prayed using your feet.)

Jesus, the Lord! Singing heart! Dancing feet! Jesus has risen! Death is defeated!

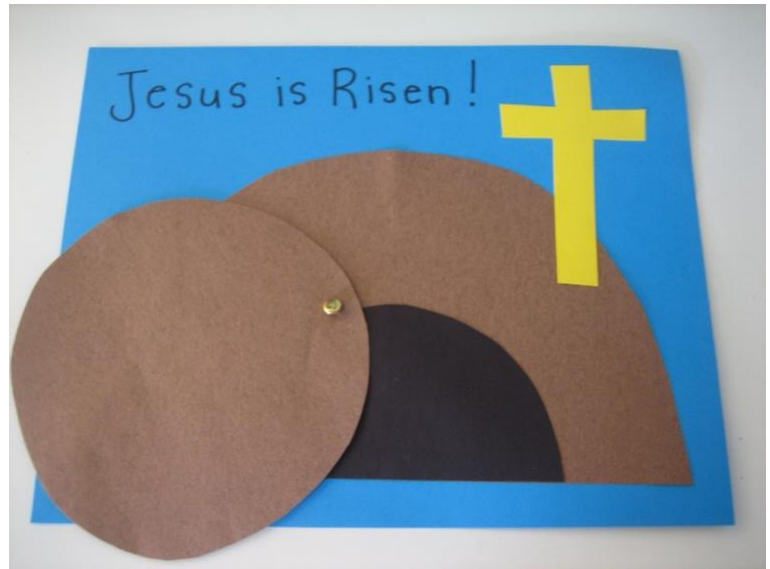
Death's done. King's won! Fear, Fun, Joy, Run! Shout with all your heart, 'Hooray for the King! Jesus our King!'

FAMILY ACTIVITY

Today we are having a party to celebrate Jesus beating death, God has the ultimate power over everything so nothing is impossible with God. So, take some time to celebrate and play together, here are a few ideas.

- **Obstacle Course** – Indoors or outdoors set up chairs, pool noodles, things to jump over, balance/walk on and make an obstacle course to complete.
