Goodness is choosing to do the right thing and not the wrong thing.

But sometimes we do the wrong thing. What can we do if that happens?

Another wonderful fruit that God makes in us is FAITHFULNESS.



Faithfulness is being loyal and having trust that God will do what he says in the Bible. And it's doing what we say we will do.

How can you be faithful?

Another wonderful fruit that God makes in us is GENTLENESS.



Gentleness is being tender with other people and animals.

How can you be gentle?

Another wonderful fruit that God makes in us is SELF-CONTROL.

Self-control is being calm when the inside of you is upset.

What upsets you? How can you be calm?



Sometimes we don't do things that God wants us to do.

When this happens we don't get to help other people, we hurt them instead.

But God helps us to say sorry and to fix up our mistakes.

How good is that?
