Role Overview

Our Gen Alpha Champion champions the cause of Children and Teenagers 30 hours a week through Highway Church. They will serve in the among children and young people as school chaplain for 20 hours per week and dedicate another 10 hours per week to youth discipleship within the church. This role focuses on facilitating wellbeing of Gen Alpha and fostering their spiritual growth.

Key Responsibilities

- **Work as a chaplain** in the Public School closest to our church in accordance with the GWFC Chaplaincy (<https://www.gwfcchaplaincy.au>) guidelines, delivering pastoral care, resilience development and wellbeing support to students, and be a liaison between school/s and church.
- **Lead the discipleship of youth** and work alongside church leadership to grow sustainable youth ministry.

- Qualifications in theology, ministry, youth work, or chaplaincy (or a willingness to work towards such qualifications).
- Experience working with children and youth, particularly Gen Alpha is desirable
- Current Working with Children Check (WWCC), Creating Safe Spaces Certification, National Police Check and relevant clearances.
